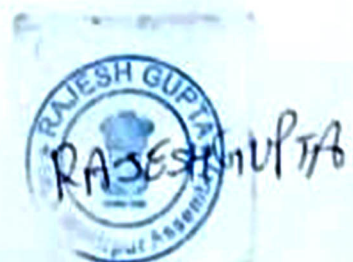

Public Health Act, 1939. The Government have prescribed regulations to prevent the outbreak of COVID-19 under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 (Central Act 3 of 1897).

In connection with your request for permission for home delivery of sanitary kits to families in Cuddalore District as well as for conducting Hand Wash Awareness campaigns in Cuddalore District, I hereby inform you that permission is accorded to deliver the sanitary kits at Town Hall, Manjakuppam, Cuddalore.

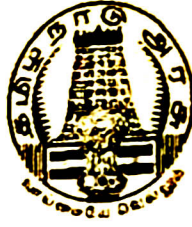


